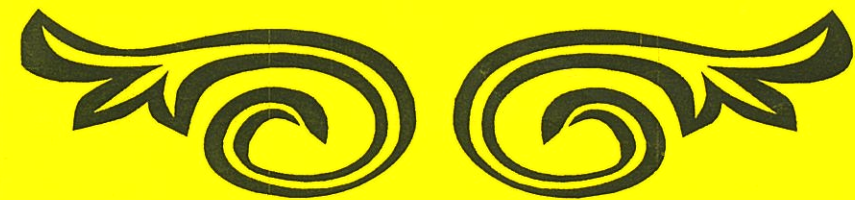

Walsall Choral Society has also been conducted by Peter since 1977 but after 30 years he will be passing on the baton to the very safe hands of new conductor Toby Barnard.

Alex Cattell won this year's Walsall Young Musician of the Year. He is a very promising music student at Aldridge School.

Norman Matthews 'Scintillations' was broadcast by the BBC in 1948 and his son Trevor offered the copies to the orchestra for this performance. Norman was Head of Geography at Blue Coat School and his music is known by generations of pupils there as he wrote the music to the Blue Coat school hymn.
